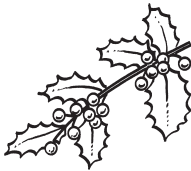

### Lue tarina Ebenezer Scroogesta.

The lions came to Trafalgar Square in 1868, when Victoria was Queen of England. Charles Dickens was a very popular writer then. His stories were about poor people in Britain. We all know Oliver Twist and David Copperfield, but his best-known character is Ebenezer Scrooge.

Scrooge is a grumpy old man who lives alone. Three ghosts visit him on Christmas Eve. One ghost makes Scrooge think about his life and mistakes. One ghost shows him how his poor employees spend Christmas. One ghost tells him that he will die alone. When Scrooge wakes up the next morning, Christmas Day, he is not the same man anymore, he is kind and generous to his poor employees and relatives.

Some people say that Dickens made Christmas happy again. The gifts, carols, plum pudding, holly and mistletoe were old customs, but Dickens brought them back.

Many words from the book are now in the English language. A “scrooge” is a person who doesn’t want to spend any money, and we say “Merry Christmas” like they said in the story.

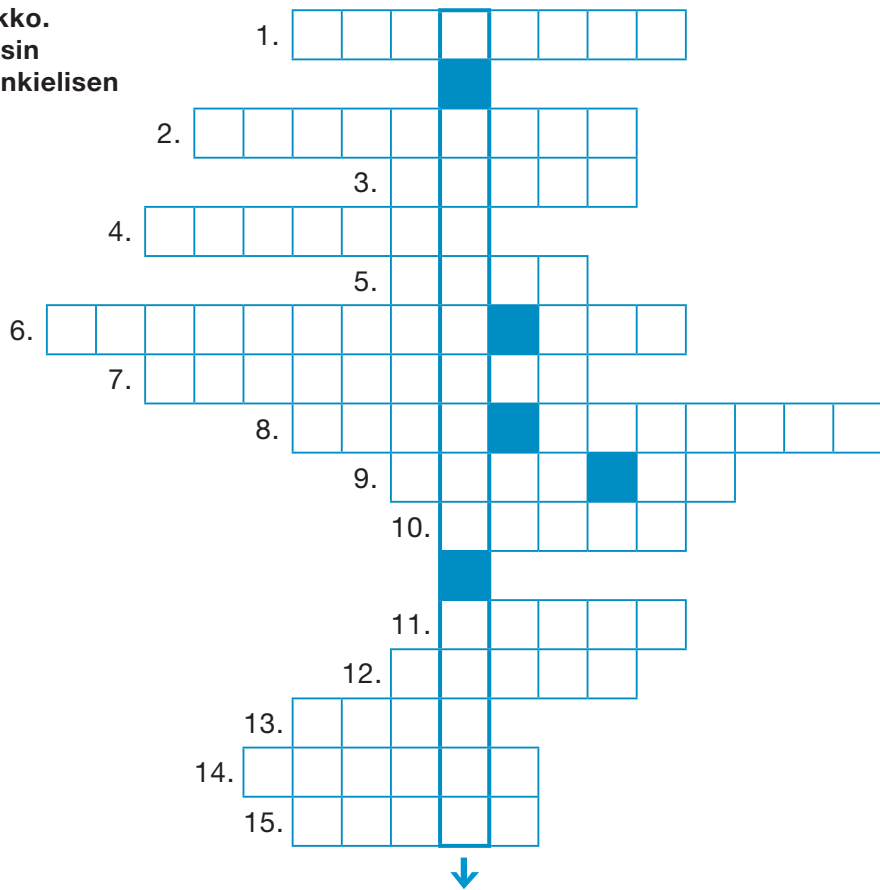

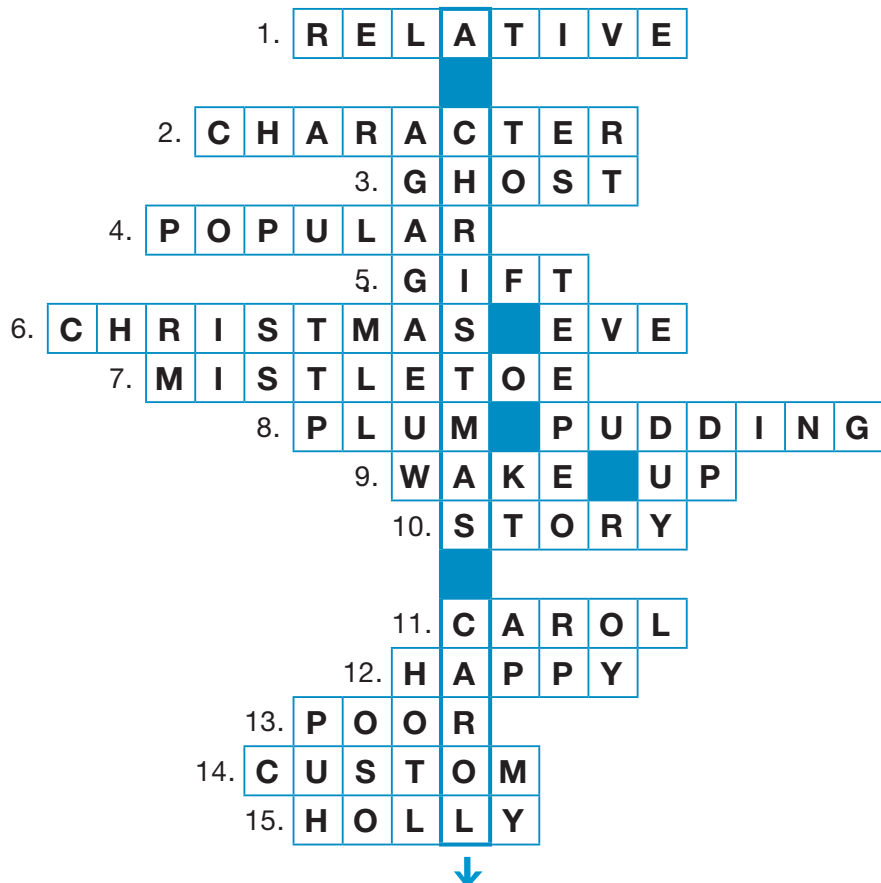
